outside work or another form of income. Their duties are to live at the house for emergency situations, implement and carry out house rules such as curfew and attending classes to help individuals to become self-sufficient and

empowered to live successful lives. The applicant must be a Christian, knowing and seeking a daily walk with Jesus Christ. They will be a part of weekly Bible studies, and help with the Heart of Hope Ministries weekly Food Pantry. In addition, the applicant must have maintained sobriety for at least 1 year.

POVERTY WITHIN OUR COMMUNITY

- 19.8% of Rock Island residents live at or below the national poverty rate that's 1 out of every 5!
- 38% are children under the age of 6.
- An additional 38% are over age 60!
- Rock Island has a rate of poverty 6.3% higher than the rest of the State of Illinois.
- Heart of Hope has provided food and toiletry items to over 71,000 individuals since opening our food pantry on May 1st, 2014!
- We have distributed 180,000 pounds of food so far this year, and delivered to 1,505 elderly and disabled neighborsin-need.
