

- ◆ We have had 4,045 visits to our Thursday Evening Drive-Through Food Pantry?
- These individuals represent 16,281 individuals within that family receiving food?
- 50% of those receiving food are children under the age of 18?
- We have delivered food and toiletry items to 1,771 elderly and disabled within the Illinois Quad Cities, with 3 to 4 teams delivering every Friday morning?
- Over 200,000 pounds of food has been distributed from our food pantry?
- Thousands of clothing items have been distributed to many families in need, including many refugee families that live in our area?
- Our first Giving Hope House resident, David Staples, will be graduating from Augustana College in May 2024, with his Bachelor's Degree?
- We are getting ready to launch new programs in 2024 to launch our vision further?
